

Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary Amounts Generally Billed

Amounts Generally Billed (AGB)

To calculate Amounts Generally Billed (AGB), Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary (the “Hospital”) uses the “look-back” method. In this method, the Hospital derives an AGB percentage based on reimbursement rates for MassHealth (PCC and MMCO) along with Private Insurers and Medicare Fee for Service for a 12 month period, divided by the gross charges for those claims. The resulting percentage is multiplied by gross charges for all emergency and medically necessary care to determine the AGB. The AGB percentage is recalculated annually.

For the 12 month period ending September 30, 2015, the AGB percentage is 42% based on the following information.

Total Charges	Claims Allowed	AGB Percentage
\$379,240,816	\$159,501,856	42%

The Hospital will not charge any individual who is eligible for financial assistance under the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Financial Assistance Policy for emergency and medically necessary care more than the AGB.
